California Coastal Cleanup is an international event with over 100 countries participating in cleanup efforts on a single day. In 2011, more than 63,000 volunteers worked together to collect nearly 600,000 pounds of trash and recyclables from California beaches, lakes, and waterways.

It reminds and inspires me to change the way I interact with our environment: To remember to bring a reusable bag to the grocery store or to bike instead of drive. This event is also about community, about coming together as neighbors to enjoy a morning together on our beautiful coastline,” says Parker.
